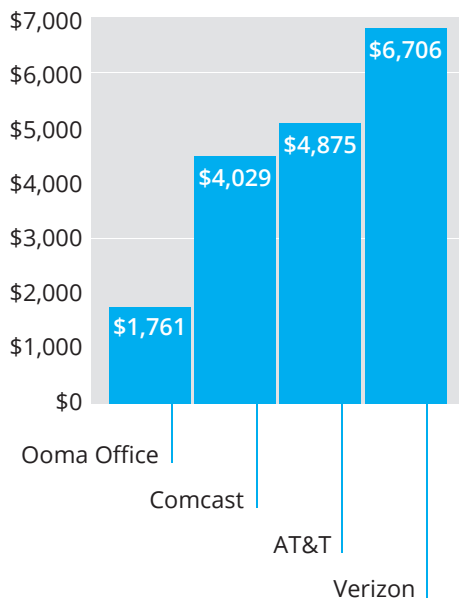
Internet Phone Service—Clear Calling for Less
